SOUTH ISLAND TENNIS LEAGUE RULES

MEETS

- All league meets between two teams are to be played outdoors at the scheduled place and time. No change of venue or time is permitted.
- Warm-ups should be completed and competitive play begun no later than 6:15 p.m.
- Each team will play four two-set doubles matches (for a total of 8 sets), by fielding two doubles pairs for each meet (i.e. at least four players). The pairs switch opponents after completing the first two matches.
- New players can be substituted in at the switch-over, but at no other time.
- No-ad play (receiver's choice) and set tie-breakers at 6-6 are to be used.
- All tennis will be played according to the "Rules of the Court" and "Code of Conduct" as published by Tennis Canada.

PLAYERS

- All team players must be at the appropriate NTRP level for the division.
- Captains may add players to their team at any time provided that any new player is a Tennis BC member or applies to be one, and their name is added to the web roster no later than 24 hours after play.
- No player may play for more than one team in the league in a season.

SCORING

- The home-team captain must enter the meet scores, including the actual players' names, no later than 24 hours after play at www.tennisbcleagues.com.
- Enter completed set scores on the website (e.g.6-3, 6-7). Incomplete or unplayed sets do not score.
- Over-all team rankings are determined by the percentage of sets won. This also determines division winners (or the play-off teams in split divisions).
- If teams are tied at the end of the regular season, winners are determined by: 1) their season head-to-head record (most sets won) 2) total sets won or 3) games won, if needed.

FORFEITS

- Teams with no doubles pairs available by 6:15 are defaulted (all 8 sets lost).
- If a team fields only one doubles pair by 6:15, then only one two-set match is played and all six remaining sets recorded as 6-0 for the other team.
- If any player is injured during play and cannot continue within 10 minutes, then that set (and that player's remaining sets) go to the other team (e.g. 6-4, 6-0) (note: an injured player can be replaced at the switch-over.)
- If play is suspended because of rain or darkness, only those sets that are completed are reported. At no time should play commence or continue under dangerous conditions.
- Captains may arrange to cancel meets in advance because of rain, but only if both agree, and only after 4:00 p.m. Tuesday.
- Rained out meets are left unplayed but must be recorded as a rainout on the scoring web.
- Violation of the rules of play may lead to the forfeit of sets and matches.

APPEALS

Any team that wishes to file a complaint concerning a violation of the rules, or request a temporary suspension of the rules for extenuating circumstances, or that wishes further clarification, or to make any suggestions in this regard, should send an e-mail to SITL at sitlinfo@yahoo.ca. Appeals of league matches must be submitted within 24 hours of the match.

While these rules are provided as a guide for players, the decisions of the SITL Committee on their interpretation or application will be final.

How Divisions Work

- If more than 12 teams are entered in a division, the division will be split randomly. If less than 12 teams enter, divisions won't be split.
- In order to make the league more competitive and enjoyable, teams that scored at the top and bottom of their divisions are encouraged to change divisions.
- Divisions with an even number of teams play more meets. In order to maximize play, the league committee reserves the right to schedule a team to play in a higher or lower division than requested on the entry form.
